Introduction to Mendeley What is Mendeley?

- Citation Management Software (CMS)
- Citations are organized by Groups, named by the user
- Records in Groups contain full citation information, abstract, .pdf and more
- Two parts: Mendeley Desktop (personal database) and Mendeley Cloud (composite database)

Introduction to Mendeley Advantages of Mendeley?

- > FREE software
- > Saves all citation information in one place
- Works with the databases to download citation information
- User may also search in Mendeley Cloud for additional citations, using the Cloud as an additional database
- Works with Word when writing a paper
- Builds the user's own personal library of favorite and significant references in one's field

Introduction to Mendeley How does Mendeley work?

- User identifies useful titles in a database and downloads them to Mendeley Desktop
- User may also enter citations manually
- User may review abstracts in Mendeley before searching for the .pdf
- More than 6000 styles available. User may also create unique styles
- In Word, the user indicates where to insert an intext citation. CMS formats the citation
- > CMS builds the bibliography

Introduction to Mendeley Why learn Mendeley?

- Saves time when researching: user selects interesting titles and reviews the abstracts later
- Mendeley Cloud serves as an additional database for recent citations
- Saves time when writing in English by formatting the citations automatically
- Stores all citations and .pdfs in one place, organized into groups
- Creates a personal repository of important citations in one's field
